VIGILANTES

When vigilantes are mentioned, the image is of quick and severe frontier citizen justice being applied to horse thieves. The coming of civilization, however, did not end the vigilantes in Kansas. Bank robberies increased to alarming proportions in the state during the 1920s. Kansas Banker's Association helped to organize vigilante groups in communities throughout the state. They were ormed, trained in marksmanship, and instructed in the correct response to attempted robberies. Some groups were never tested, but same chased and shot bank robbers. There is disagreement an the influences of the vigilantes in curbing bank holdups. Eventually it was concluded that professional law officers were needed to cotch professional criminals, and the vigilantes possed into Kansas history.
